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Terms of Reference

Committee Purpose

- 1. Maintain active oversight of developments, issues and good practice in relation to the Prevent Duty.
- 2. Oversee protocols and procedures that reflect a best practice approach to safeguarding.

Membership

- 3. The membership of the Committee shall be made up of:
 - The Disability Consultant
 - Student Welfare Officer
 - Industry Liaison
 - Academic and Registry Officer

<u>Quorum</u>

4. The quorum for meetings will be 3 members.

Frequency of Meetings

5. The committee will meet once a term.

Reporting

6. The committee will report directly into the SLT.

Duties

- 7. Annual review of approach to student welfare and support services
- 8. Annual review of approach regarding external speakers, industry guests in relation to academic freedom and freedom of speech.



9. Annual review of designated safeguarding roles and procedures.

<u>Remit</u>

- 10. Maintain active oversight of the Prevent risk register, reviewing this on an annual basis.
- 11. Review and monitor delivery of the Prevent action plan.
- 12. Monitor and review data that evidences compliance with the Prevent Duty, including that prepared for submission to the OfS.
- 13. Ensure clear accountability and training for those with responsibility for safeguarding.
- 14. Share learning and casework developments to improve awareness and compliance.
- 15. Identify training requirements (induction and refresher); appropriateness of training offer and training engagement data.
- 16. To review and update at each meeting the individual risk register relating to **safeguarding risks.** Risks within this register might include, but are not limited to:
 - Non-compliance with legal safeguarding responsibilities.
 - Non-compliance with Prevent duty under the Counter-Terrorism and Security Act 2015.

Any changes to this individual risk register will be referred to the Senior Leadership Team within 5 working days alongside the minutes of this committee for inclusion within the Institutional Risk Register.

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
