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Terms of Reference

Committee Purpose

1. To review the day-to-day implementation of the Curriculum and propose minor amendments to its substance and implementation to the Academic Board.
2. Propose training initiatives

Membership

3. The membership of the Committee shall be made up of:
 - Head of Voice
 - Head of Movement
 - Head of Film and TV
 - 1 member of the SLT
 - 1 member of Freelance staff
 - 2 Students (one student will be a student on one of the part time courses, and one student will be a student on the full-time BA)
4. The Chair of the Committee will be chosen by the SLT from amongst the Committee Members.

Quorum

5. The quorum for meetings will be 4 members, and must include at least one student representative and the Chair of the Committee.

Frequency of Meetings

6. The committee will meet a minimum of once a term.

Reporting

7. The committee will report directly into the Curriculum Development Committee and The Academic Board.

Duties

8. To review how the curriculum is being taught and received by the students on a day-to-day basis.
9. To seek student feedback on the curriculum (through the student representatives) and propose changes to the way in which the curriculum is being taught and assessed following that feedback.
10. To seek freelance tutor feedback on the curriculum (through the freelance staff representative) and propose changes to the way in which the curriculum is being taught and assessed following that feedback.
11. To seek feedback from members of the Committee on the curriculum and its implementation.
12. To propose amendments to, and new initiatives relating to delivery of, the curriculum to the Curriculum Development Committee and Academic Board.
